high and low ropes challenge

Our challenge course strives to promote team building, goal setting, communication skills, and creative problem solving. Participants gain confidence, trust, and a deeper awareness of their own abilities by challenging themselves and others to achieve their best.

Come for a day or a whole weekend! Both high and low ropes courses are available to accommodate your time. Comfortable housing is available if you would like your group to spend more than an afternoon at the course.

Low Ropes

Our low ropes course includes a variety of elements designed to facilitate group building while staying less than 6 feet above the ground. Groups complete the elements together, bonding and learning to work as a team. Low ropes activities stress cooperation, not competition. Our low ropes elements include A-Frames, Texas Skis, Family Balancing Act, and many others.

High Ropes

Progressing from low ropes, our high ropes course, Leap of Faith, is both an individual and partner challenge. Participants will utilize the skills learned through the low ropes elements. Elements are 30-40 feet above the ground. Participants wear safety equipment similar to rock climbing and are connected to facilitators on the ground. You'll experience the Dangling Duo, Multivine, Power Pole, Zip Line, and others. Participants must be at least 13 years of age.
