### CAMP BASICS

Campers at *Badlands Ministries* are placed in small groups with young adult counselors who guide them through each day of activities. Our ministry strives to bring our Christian faith to the reality of today's children and youth, and our summer programs emphasize faith growth, relationship building, love for God's creation, and developing young leaders.

We hope this summer is a time for your whole family to grow in faith through this experience! Parents are welcome to tour the camp when you arrive for check-in and to participate in our closing worship on the last day of camp at 10am. We believe that the home is a very special place for the faith formation of your child, and are proud to be your partners on this journey we call faith.

### HEALTH FORM

If you registered online using our innovative and safe process, you have already filled out your camper's health form and do not need to do anything else. If you prefer to register using a paper form, please download a health form from our website and bring it with you during camper check-in. If your camper takes medication regularly through the school year, please continue that schedule through his/her time at camp. All medications will be kept in the Medic Station. Please supply all medications in their prescription bottle or original container during check-in.

### REMAINING BALANCE

Registering online allows you to pay your camper's deposit and remaining balance at any time with your Visa or MasterCard. To keep your registration as simple as possible, we ask you to please pay your remaining balance one month prior to coming to camp. Please follow this same time frame if you registered via paper registration.

### CHECK IN

Check-in is on Sunday at 2:00 PM in the Staff House/Canteen. This will be a time for the SITs and counselors to start the week with a staff meeting, allowing adequate time for SITs to be paired with a counselor and go over expectations for the week.

### CANTEEN

*Badlands Ministries* offers an assortment of snacks and souvenirs in the Canteen. Campers are allowed one beverage and one snack item per day. **The cost for daily snacks and beverages is included in the registration cost, as well as a 2022 camp t-shirt!** Other merchandise ranges from \$5.00 - \$45.00 and can be purchased on the first and last days of your child's camp session.

### SERVANT PROJECT DONATION

Each summer, *Badlands Ministries* collects items as an in-kind offering to share our resources with those who need them to live out our Christian faith through service. Last summer, we collected over 1100 non-perishable items to distribute to area food pantries. **This year we will be making quilts for Lutheran world relief. If you would like to donate fabric or thread, that would be greatly appreciated.**

- Shorts - *do not bring short-shorts*
- T-shirts - *do not bring spaghetti-strings, halters, or cutoffs*
- Clean underwear for a week & extra socks
- Swimsuit - *one piece only, do not bring a 2-piece*
- Long pants
- Sweatshirt - *a hooded sweatshirt is great!*
- Water shoes for the river
- Sweat pants
- Jacket or windbreaker
- Tennis shoes
- A working flashlight - *check those batteries!*
- Insect repellent
- Back pack
- Water bottle
- Sun screen & hat
- Personal toiletries
- DEODORANT!
- Camera - *optional*
- Completed health form - *if you did not register online*
- Items for Servant Project—**Fabric and thread**
- \*Cell phones are optional! *You will have limited service and are only able to access them for 1 hour each day.*

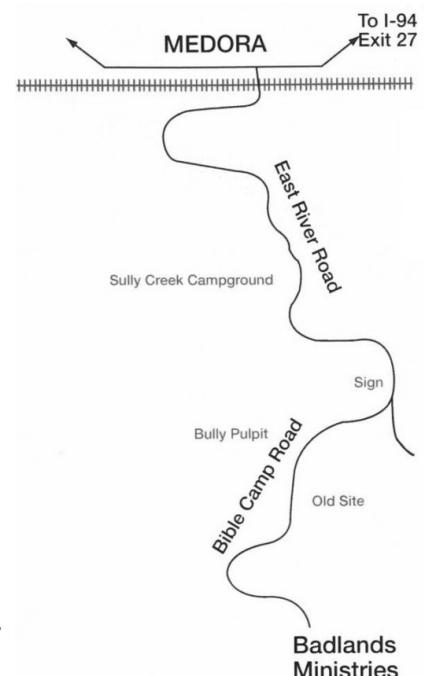
