CAMP BASICS

Campers at *Badlands Ministries* are placed in small groups with young adult counselors who guide them through each day of activities. Our ministry strives to bring our Christian faith to the reality of today's children and youth, and our summer programs emphasize faith growth, relationship building, love for God's creation, and developing young leaders.

We hope this summer is a time for your whole family to grow in faith through this experience! We believe that the home is a very special place for the faith formation of your child, and are proud to be your partners on this journey we call faith. HEALTH FORM

If you registered online using our innovative and safe process, you have already filled out your camper's health form and do not need to do anything else. If you prefer to register using a paper form, please download a health form from our website and bring it with you during camper check-in. If your camper takes medication regularly through the school year, please continue that schedule through his/her time at camp. All medications will be kept in the Medic Station or with our medic. Please supply all medications in their prescription bottle or original container during check-in.

REMAINING BALANCE

Registering online allows you to pay your camper's deposit and remaining balance at any time with your Visa or MasterCard. To keep your registration as simple as possible, we ask you to please pay your remaining balance **one month prior to coming to camp**. Please follow this same time frame if you registered via paper registration.

CHECK IN/Wrangler Camp Specifics

Check-in is on the first day of your camp session from 4:00 PM - 5:00 PM outside the Church*. This is a time for you to get your camper settled into their cabin for the week. They will be spending a few nights at our Professional Wrangler's ranch during the week. Our medic will be available to take medications and follow up on any camper health concerns listed on your health form. To respect our staff's time, please do not arrive before 4:00 PM on check-in day. *If weather doesn't cooperate, a table will be set up in the Dining Hall.

Our Wrangler program will be travelling to our Professional Wrangler Heidi Petermann's ranch. Campers will be staying at the camp Sunday and leaving for the ranch on Monday. They will stay at the ranch with our staff through Wednesday Evening and finish up their camp week onsite.

CANTEEN

Badlands Ministries offers an assortment of snacks and souvenirs in the Canteen. Campers are allowed one beverage and one snack item per day. **The cost for daily snacks and beverages is included in the registration cost, as well as a 2026 camp t-shirt!** Other merchandise ranges from \$5.00 - \$45.00 and can be purchased on the last day of your child's camp session or visit our camp store online at <https://badlandsministriescanteen.square.site/>

SERVANT PROJECT DONATION

Each summer, *Badlands Ministries* collects items as an in-kind offering to share our resources with those who need them to live out our Christian faith through service. WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

What To Bring: *Please Put Your Name On EVERYTHING!*

- An attitude ready for adventure, fun, and growth!
- A Bible you are comfortable reading
If you don't have one, we recommend the NIV Student Bible or the Faith Alive Bible. Both are available on amazon.com or in most bookstores
- Sleeping bag & pillow - *water resistant sleeping bag*
- Two towels - *one for the shower and one for the river/pool*
- Rain gear - *a nylon poncho is good, rubber makes you sweat*
- Shorts - *do not bring short-shorts*
- T-shirts - *do not bring spaghetti-straps, halters, cutoffs, crop tops*
- Clean underwear for a week & extra socks
- Swimsuit - *one piece only, do not bring a 2-piece*
- Jeans for the days spent at the ranch
- Sweatshirt - *a hooded sweatshirt is great!*
- Water shoes for the river
- Items for specialized camps—*Closed toed shoes for horses/jeans, etc.*
- Sweatpants
- Jacket or windbreaker
- Tennis shoes—*for games and hiking*
- A working flashlight - *check those batteries!*
- Insect repellent
- Back pack
- Water bottle
- Sun screen & hat
- Personal toiletries
- DEODORANT!
- Camera - *optional—not a phone—*
- Completed health form - *if you did not register online*
- Items for Servant Project—*non-perishable food*

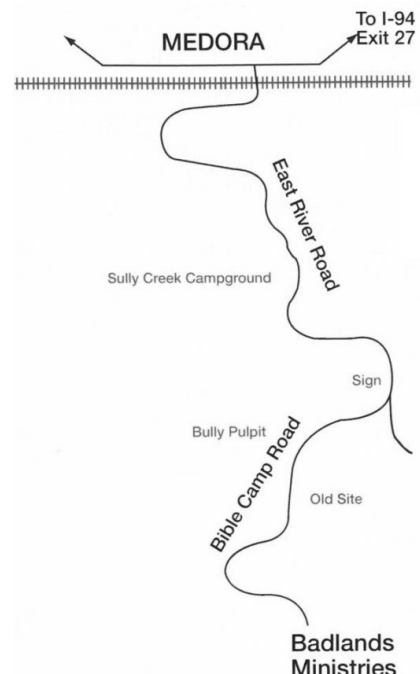
